- Asks Mary Magdalene three (3) times in John 20 (20:2, 13, 15)
- The Whereabouts of Jesus (John 1:38; 7:34; 8:21-23; 9:12; 12:26; 13:33, 36; 14:4-6)
- Jesus is Closer Than You Think (John 15:4; 20:14, 19)

B. "Mary"

- John 20:16, compare with John 10:3
- My God, and Your God (John 20:17, compare with Jeremiah 31:33)
- Weeping (John 20:11), Turning (John 20:14) and Announcing (John 20:18)

- John 17:22-23
