“Not the same horn in Chapter 7:8, which will arise out of the restored Romam Empire. This little horn came out of Greece and refers to Antiochus Epiphanes, who came to the throne in 175 B.C., and plundered the Temple in Jerusalem, desecrating it by offering pig's flesh on the alter.”

- Daniel Chapter 8:13-14

Reference Note from Ryrie Study Bible KJV

“Antiochus' persecution of the Jews would last 2,300 days. The period from 171B.B. (when peaceful relations between Antiochus and the Jews came to an end) to December 25, 165 B.C. (when Judas Maccabeus restored the Temple to its proper worship.”
