

Pray to Send John 17:18

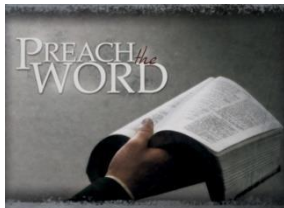
- PRAY that the Lord would SEND YOU :

- Isaiah 6:8, “Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: ‘Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?’ Then I said, ‘Here am I! SEND me.’”
- You will never get serious about missions until you start praying that God will send you (use you).



- PRAY that the Lord will SEND PREACHERS :

- Preaching – “The highest, greatest, and most glorious calling,” “the primary task of the Church,” “when preaching goes down, personal counseling goes up,” and “in the history of the Church, the greatest times of decline have been when preaching has declined.” (D. Martyn Lloyd-Jones)



- Romans 10:14a-15b – “And how shall they hear without a preacher? And how shall they preach unless they are SENT.”
- “We PREACH Christ crucified...” (1 Cor 1:23)
- “Yet when I PREACH the gospel, I cannot boast, for I am compelled to PREACH. Woe to me if I do not PREACH the gospel!” (1 Cor 9:16)

- “For we do not PREACH ourselves, but Jesus Christ as Lord...” (2 Cor 4:5)
- “...to reveal His Son in me, that I might PREACH Him among the Gentiles.” (Gal 1:16)
- “This grace was given, that I should PREACH among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ.” (Eph 3:8)
- “What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is PREACHED; and in this I rejoice, yes, and will rejoice.” (Phil 1:18)
- “I was appointed a PREACHER...” (1 Tim 2:7)
- “To which I was appointed a PREACHER...” (2 Tim 1:11)
- “PREACH the word! Be ready in season and out of season.” (2 Tim 4:2)
- “And this gospel of the kingdom will be PREACHED in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.” (Matt 24:14)
- “Go into all the world and PREACH the gospel to every creature.” (Mark 16:15)
- “That repentance and remission of sins should be PREACHED in His name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.” (Luke 24:47)
- “I am ready to PREACH the gospel to you who are in Rome also.” (Rom 1:15)

- PRAY that the Lord will SEND us to UNREACHED PLACES :

- Romans 15:20-21 – “It has always been my ambition to preach the gospel where Christ was not known, so that I would not be building on someone else’s foundation. Rather, as it is

written: ‘Those who were not told about Him will see, and those who have not heard will understand.’”

- NLT – “...where the name of Christ has never been heard...”

- Mauritania – 3,900,000 Muslims, 5,000 Christians.

- Afghanistan – 32,000,000 Muslims, 1,000-3,000 Christians.

- Turkey – 74,730,000 Muslims, 35,000 Christians.

- Does it trouble your spirit that:

- There are 126 million Japanese who are lost?
- There are more Jehovah Witnesses in Poland than Evangelicals?
- There are 62 million Buddhists in Thailand?
- There are 177 million Muslims in Pakistan?
- There are 1 billion lost souls in China?
- There are 800 million Hindus in India?

- 2 Cor 8:6 – “...see that you also excel in this grace of giving.”
- 2 Cor 8:3-4 – “For I testify that they gave as much as they were able, and even beyond their ability. Entirely on their own, they urgently pleaded with us for the privilege of sharing in this service to the saints.”

- PRAY that the Lord will SEND THE WORD through technology:

- Acts 19:20 – “The word of the Lord grew mightily and prevailed.”
- Acts 12:24 – “The word of God grew and multiplied.”
- Acts 12:24 – “The message of God was spreading, reaching more and more people.”
- 2 Thess 3:1 – “Pray that the Lord’s teaching will continue to spread quickly. And pray that people will give honor to that teaching.”
- Acts 6:7 – “Then the word of God spread, and the number of the disciples multiplied greatly in Jerusalem, and a great many of the priests were obedient to the faith.”



- PRAY that the Lord will SEND MUCH MONEY through us to missions:

- 2 Cor 9:9 – “Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous. And when we take your
